All students are required to wear our school uniform in accordance with the school's uniform rules. We are very proud of how smart our students look and we believe that a smart and consistent uniform gives our students a strong sense of belonging and of identity.

Students are also expected to wear the uniform correctly on the way to and from school.

Item	Requirements
Blazer (compulsory) & Pullover (optional)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Navy Blue Blazer with school badge (from uniform suppliers) ● Navy Blue V-neck pullover. This can be worn under the blazer. They may not be worn instead of a blazer
Shirt & Tie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Angmering School Tie, 'clip on' or standard available uniform suppliers. ● Tailored plain 'button up' Shirt or Blouse, White for Y7, 8 and 9 and Sky Blue for Y10 and 11. They must be buttoned up, tucked in and must not be sleeveless.
Trousers, Skirt and Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Black Tailored Trousers or Knee Length Tailored Black Shorts. ● X Not Allowed: Leggings or jeggings / Jogging bottoms / sweatpants / Any stretchy material trousers / Jeans (of any kind). ● Tartan Skirt from our uniform suppliers (optional as an alternative to school trousers or shorts – no other skirt allowed). ● Skirts must not be rolled up or adjusted to make them shorter.
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Black shoes that can be polished. ● X Not Allowed: Sportswear brands, flip flops; heels or fabric shoes. ● Boots are permitted in winter, but only black smart boots and these must also be able to be polished and not from a sportswear brand. ● Trousers must not be tucked into boots.

P.E. Kit

The Angmering branded items listed below should be purchased from our uniform suppliers either [Ricara Schoolwear](https://ricaraschoolwear.co.uk/) or [McGregors](https://mcgregorsuniforms.co.uk/). The plain navy-blue shorts, sports leggings or tracksuit bottoms, which can be worn as alternatives, can be purchased from any store.

- Navy/Green PE polo Shirt (Angmering School logo) - **compulsory**
- Navy/Green Angmering PE Shorts – **optional** (plain navy-blue shorts, sports leggings or tracksuit bottoms can be worn as an alternative)
- Navy/Green Angmering PE Skort - **optional** (plain navy-blue shorts, sports leggings or tracksuit bottoms can be worn as an alternative)
- Navy/Green Angmering PE Hooded Jumper - **optional** - some activities will require the hood to be tucked in for safety.
- Navy Football Socks for outdoor sports and white socks for indoor sports

Below is some guidance on other equipment that is needed for PE Lessons at The Angmering School:

- Trainers (with correct support)
- Studded boots for rugby and football but please note these are not permitted on the AstroTurf.

- Gum Shield -essential for Hockey and Rugby Union. These are on sale in the PE office for £3
- Shin Pads are recommended for Football and Hockey

In P.E. students are required to be in their PE kits for every lesson even if they are ill or injured, unless the nature of the injury prevents them from getting changed..

Nearly new uniform shop: We have a stock of good quality, second hand uniforms held on the school site. Should parents wish to purchase items, please complete the attached Google form and we will endeavour to source the uniform, if in stock.

We will contact you to let you know the requested uniform is available and this can be paid via ParentPay or cash in a sealed envelope. Once payment is received the items will be available for collection.

The Headship Team reserves the right to ban any items considered high fashion.

IMPORTANT: If a student is not wearing a full school uniform for any reason, they must bring a note from a parent/guardian.

- When they arrive at school, they must go to Student Services first thing in the morning.
- There they will show the note and receive a permission card that allows them to be out of uniform that day.

For medical reasons that require being out of uniform for a longer period of time:

- The student needs a special card signed by a member of the Headship Team (senior school leadership)

Helpful Uniform Tips

- All of our uniform is available from [RICARA Schoolwear](#) and [McGregors](#) but you can purchase what you need from any High Street shop except for the badge for your blazer, Skirt, Tie and PE Polo Shirt
- Students can wear their own coats but they must be removed in class. Hoodies or tracksuit tops are not permitted, even when worn in place of a coat.
- Blazers are to be worn at all times, including between lessons. It may only be removed if the teacher gives permission, the students are playing games at break/lunch or the Head teacher deems the weather is too hot for blazers.
- Ties need to be tied correctly with the full school logo showing below the knot
- Shoes must have a low heel (no more than 4cm)
- Socks to be black
- Tights or socks may be worn, but not both
- All tights must be natural coloured or black. Fashion tights or patterned tights are not permitted
- Make-up must be subtle. If it is heavy and obvious, students will be asked to remove it. False eye lashes are not permitted.

- One single or one pair of small stud-earrings only. No other piercings are permitted and students will be asked to remove them if they arrive with any other piercings
- No sweatbands
- Small necklaces only, and these are to be tucked inside school shirts/blouses
- Bracelets, bangles, beads, large rings and anklets are NOT allowed
- Nails must be no longer than two millimetres above the fingertip. No nail polish, fake nails or acrylic nails are allowed.
- Hair accessories must be navy, black, white or neutral (hair) colour. Hair slides must be simple and without decoration
- Hair, if coloured, must be a natural colour (ie not red, green, etc)
- Belts, if necessary, should be black
- Scarves may be any colour but must be removed in lessons
- No tattoos
- Plain white vests or T-shirts may be worn under school shirts but must not be visible
