# Re: Burnley vs Manchester City Residential, 2<sup>nd</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> April 2022

Further to my letter last week, I am writing to inform you of the details for the upcoming trip. We have been in discussion with the tour company regarding the structure of the football experience and they have provided the below information.

## Saturday 2nd April

**6.30PM -** Arrive at Hotel (Premier Inn, Preston Central)

7.30PM - Dinner

8.00AM - Breakfast

**10.00AM - Training Session with Coaches** 

12.30PM - Arrive at Old Trafford

1.00PM - Visit Museum

1.15PM - Education Session

1.45PM - Stadium Tour

**3.00PM - Depart to School** 

**8.30PM -** Arrive at Angmering School.

This is a provisional itinerary as a further conversation with the coach company is needed a few days prior to the tour just in case any roadworks or road issues arise which might mean slight alterations. However if this was the case, timings will only be slightly adjusted and you will be made aware if anything was to change.

#### Dinner

Students will all have food from a buffet style set up from the hotel and this will be made up of the following

MAINS: Beef burgers, sausages, margherita pizza and vegetable tomato pasta

**SIDES:** Garlic bread, chips, beans and salad

**DESSERTS:** Chocolate brownie, fruit salad and vanilla ice cream

Breakfast the following day will also be provided buffet style.

Students will be expected to wear their own clothes, these must be designed with practical activity in mind including football boots (moulds as it will be on astroturf) if you would like to wear them for the training session. They will also need an overnight bag and toiletries

### Medication

If your child needs to take prescribed or non prescribed medication with them on the trip, please make sure that it is clearly named and in original packaging. This should be given to Miss Rushin on the morning of the trip. Please complete the attached medication consent form if your child is taking medication with them and give this to Miss Rushin.

Accommodation will be in the form of rooms of twos and threes with single beds, split in genders and year groups. Students have been placed into rooms already based on this as well as asking students their preferences and rooms will be allocated on the day.

Lunch is **not** provided either day, however we will be stopping on the route at various service stations to ensure students can get food and drink. Students may give their money to a designated member of staff for the weekend to ensure this is kept safe, if this is preferred.

Students will need to arrive **no later than 6am on Saturday 2**<sup>nd</sup> **April** to ensure that we are able to register all students prior to getting on the coach. The sites team have been informed about the provisional leaving and return times to ensure the main gate is open to drop and pick up students. However, please could you try and park in the staff car park to leave the bus layby free for the coach and to ensure student safety.
