### **Mrs Fillery - Head of Year 7**

As Head of Year, she oversees the overall progress, attendance, behaviour, and wellbeing of the year group. She will work closely with the wider pastoral team, families, and outside agencies when needed, to ensure every student receives the support they need to reach their potential. In addition to her pastoral responsibilities, she will also organise and run many of the school activities for the year group. Her aim is to create a positive and supportive environment where every student feels valued and encouraged to succeed both academically and personally.

## Student Support Officers

Student Support Officers work with our Heads of Year, responding to issues that may arise during the school day. These may range from first aid needs and lost property, to supporting students who feel worried or upset.

Their priority is to support students in returning to lessons as quickly as possible, while recognising that some matters may require follow-up at a later stage.

## Group Tutors

Tutors meet with the students in their groups every morning at START and also lead DEAR (drop everything and read) every day. The group tutors are the constant presence for students and have an overview of attendance, ARC points and will lead on inter-tutor activities.

Your child will find out their tutor group when they attend the transition day on the 1st July 2026.



## Group Tutors

At The Angmering School, your child's tutor group will play an important role in their school life. Students will remain with the same tutor group for the next five years, so it is essential that we create the right mix from the very beginning.

To help us do this, we talk to Year 6 teachers to find out who they work well with and how they learn best. We also look at other helpful information, student attendance and learning behaviours, to make sure we're creating groups where everyone can feel comfortable, supported, and ready to succeed.

We know how important it is to have familiar faces around you, so we do our best to make sure that, where possible, everyone is placed with at least one person they know and work well with. At the same time, we want to help students to grow in confidence, meet new people, and build friendships that will last throughout their time at Angmering.

Because of how carefully we put the tutor groups together, we ask parents and carers not to make requests about who should or shouldn't be placed together. We really appreciate your understanding and trust in this process.



## Uniform and Equipment

Our Uniform is an Angmering School blazer and tie with a white shirt. Black straight legged tailored trousers/black tailored knee length shorts, or the school tartan skirt with black leather or leather look shoes.

You can purchase what you need from any high street shop except: the badge for your blazer, skirt, tie, PE polo shirt and shorts/skort.

Students can wear their own coats but they must be removed in class. Hoodies, tracksuit tops or cardigans are not permitted, even when worn in place of a coat.

Blazers are to be worn at all times, including between lessons. It may only be removed if the teacher approves of removal, the students are playing games at break/lunch or the Head teacher deems the weather is too hot. The Headship Team reserves the right to ban any items considered high fashion.

**IMPORTANT:** If your child is out of school uniform, for any reason, they will need a note from you and then they can go to Student Services first thing in the morning to get a permission card for missing uniform. Genuine medical reasons require a card signed by a member of the Headship Team.
