Transition Day

- Date: Wednesday 1 July 2026
- Time: 8.30am to 3pm
- Gates: Vehicles will not be allowed on site unless previously agreed with the LNC or with Mrs Fillery. If your child has mobility issues please liaise with the LNC for permission. The Bramley Green gate will be open at 8.10am. The front gate, by the field, will open at 8.10am. Students (only) will be directed to the canteen, where they will be met by their tutor.
- Medication needed by students during the day can be handed to staff on the gate. It must be in a named bag.
- Students need to wear their primary school uniform.
- Please send your child with a packed lunch. Alternatively, they may bring cash for the canteen. £3 will buy them a meal. A Free School Meal will be provided for students who have this at their primary school. (The canteen will take cash on induction day but please do remember that in September the canteen can only be used via money on parent pay.)
