## Attendance

All aspects of your child's learning at our school are important, alongside good timekeeping, punctuality and attendance. Together, these elements help to ensure a successful and positive school experience.

START, our tutor time programme, begins at 8:45am and all students are expected to be on site by 8:40am. To support a calm and organised start to the day, the school gates open from 8:20am. Students are registered for every lesson, so punctuality throughout the school day is essential. Good attendance is recognised and celebrated throughout the year, both individually and within tutor groups.

With only 40 school weeks each year, we kindly ask that family holidays are taken during the school holiday periods wherever possible.

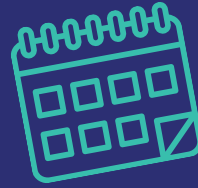
## Home Learning

Home learning plays an essential part in students' education and parents and carers play a key role in encouraging and supporting their child in this area of their school life.

At KS3, the home learning set will support students to build up their independent work to improve their subject knowledge and skills outside of the classroom to ensure that good habits are in place for GCSEs. In order to support this transition, there will be a staggered introduction of homework in year 7 to ensure that students are not overwhelmed. This will be communicated to parents in September. All homework can be monitored via the Bromcom/MCAS app.
