#### You can get into this job through:

- A University course
- An Apprenticeship
- A Trainee scheme

#### **Career Progression**

With at least 2 years' experience and extra training, you could become:

- a team leader
- a specialist paramedic
- an emergency care practitioner

You could also move into operations management, education and training, or train to work in other areas of healthcare, for example nursing.

You'll need to do a paramedic science degree approved

for a university paramedic qualification while working at the same time.

#### Day to day tasks

Day to day, you could:

- respond to emergency calls
- assess situations when you arrive and check details with others at the scene, like the police
- work calmly and quickly to stabilise patients
- use a defibrillator to revive patients
- give patients medicines and injections
- help to deliver babies
- attend non-emergency calls and • decide whether patients need to go to hospital
- check equipment regularly and keep accurate records
- reassure family and members of the public who are on the scene
