Year 11 GCSE exam preparation

This is just a further reminder that the main exams start on **16th May** (next Monday). **All lessons will run as normal until Friday 27th May** (the end of this half term), with students only being out of lessons to sit their exams. <u>There is no study leave prior to May half term break</u>. From **Monday 6th June**, after the half term break, students will be on study leave and only attending school to take exams.

All students have their own personalised exam timetable and will be provided with plenty of guidance from their teachers on what they need to know and be able to do for each exam paper. If they need any additional guidance or support please encourage them to contact their teachers directly via email, google classroom or in person.

Students have been reminded that when they go into any exam they must abide by the following rules:

- Wear full school uniform
- Keep your stationery items in a clear plastic bag or clear plastic pencil case
- Leave **mobile phones** and **smart watches** outside the exam hall (with phones switched off or on silent)
