A Reminder About Our Uniform

As the weather is forecast to start cooling down in the coming days and weeks I thought it would be sensible to send a reminder about our uniform rules as they relate to colder weather.

- Students are welcome to wear a plain T-shirt under their school shirt provided it is not visible
- Students may add a plain navy blue jumper or sweatshirt (NOT hoodie) under their blazer but it must not have any logo and cannot be worn in place of a blazer
- Black tights of any thickness are acceptable but socks should not be worn over tights
- Coats can be worn over blazers at breaks and lunches but should be removed as students enter the buildings. Hoodies cannot be worn as an alternative to a coat.
- As a separate but related reminder please ensure that school uniform skirts are not shortened from their original length. We understand that skirt waistbands may need to be altered to improve the fit but please ensure that the length remains unchanged.

Limiting vehicle access to the site to ensure students' safety

As was the case throughout last year we do not allow parents/carers to drive their vehicles onto the school site during drop off or pick up times. The only exception to this is for children with physical disabilities which make it significantly difficult for them to make their own way in from Greenwood Drive or Bramley Green. All eligible parents/carers should have yellow permits to display on their dashboards or in their windscreens. The LNC team will continue to manage the allocation of these permits and will be happy to help new parents/carers who wish to apply for one.

If your child does not fall into this small group you need to drop your child in the surrounding area so that they can walk onto the school site. This will ensure we minimise on-site traffic, increasing safety and maintaining access for buses and emergency vehicles.
