March 3rd 2026	Email from County regarding allocated school place
March 2026	Initial contact with feeder primary schools This will initially be focused on any individual students who may need an enhanced transition programme
March 2026	We ask you to complete a Data Collection form to ensure a smooth transition, ensuring we can communicate with you and support your child's needs. It will take you approximately 10 minutes to complete. It is on the transition page. transition area In this you can request a phone call from our safeguarding team to discuss any concerns you may have. In this form we ask for feedback on language preferences.. A language will be studied until the end of Year 9. Your reply is purely to give us an idea of preference and does not guarantee this is the language which will be allocated in Y7.

May 2026	We will be in touch with a link to MCAS which is a platform which we use currently for information and academic reports throughout the school year. A separate email with instructions will be generated from MCAS which will be sent to your email address - after May half term.
May/June 2026	Visits from key staff to primary schools These will be arranged with the schools to ensure we meet every student
June 2026 Thursday 4th June and Wednesday 17th June. 5-7pm	Enrichment Evenings These are an opportunity for new year 7 students to come up to the school, meet new friends and try a range of activities. Please complete the google form to book a place for your child to take part and come along. Again, the booking form is on the transition website page. transition area We also invite parents/carers on the 2nd enrichment evening, Wednesday 17th June 6.15pm - 7pm to join us for a cup of tea/coffee and to have the opportunity to meet parents and staff while you wait to collect the students from their activities.
July 1st 2026	Induction Day We are looking forward to face to face events with students during the day. Plus we will have an evening for parents to attend that evening from 6-8pm with an opportunity to meet the tutors and ask any questions you may have.

Thursday September 2026	First day of timetabled lessons for all students
