CAREER OF THE WEEK

PARAMEDICS RESPOND TO EMERGENCY CALL-OUTS
AND GIVE PEOPLE LIFE-SAVING MEDICAL HELP

YOU CAN GET INTO THIS CAREER BY:

- a university course
- an apprenticeship
- working towards this role
- a trainee scheme

CAREER PROGRESSION:

With at least 2 years' experience and extra training, you could become:

- a team leader
- a specialist paramedic
- an emergency care practitioner

You could also move into operations management, education and training, or train to work in other areas of healthcare, for example nursing.



UNIVERSITY

You'll need to do a paramedic science degree approved by the Health and Care Professions Council.

Full-time courses usually take 3 years.

You may be able to get extra student financial support through the NHS Learning Support Fund.

APPRENTICESHIP

You could apply to do a Paramedic Level 6 Degree Apprenticeship.

This takes 3 years to complete and is a mix of on-the-job training and classroom learning.

OTHER ROUTES

You could apply for a training scheme as a student paramedic with an ambulance service.

You would study for a university paramedic qualification while working at the same time.

Paramedic



DAY TO DAY YOU COULD:

- respond to emergency calls
- assess situations when you arrive and check details with others at the scene, like the police
- work calmly and quickly to stabilise patients
- use a defibrillator to revive patients
- give patients medicines and injections
- help to deliver babies
- attend non-emergency calls and decide whether patients need to go to hospital
- check equipment regularly and keep accurate records
- reassure family and members of the public who are on the scene

Should you injure yourself or feel unwell during or between lessons, please let your teacher know and they will contact a member of the on call team to come and see you in your classroom.

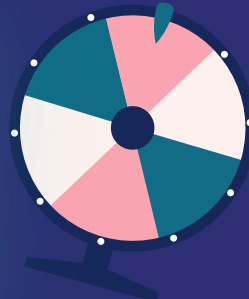
