Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are excited to be working with Angmering School this year to deliver an unforgettable experience for students in Year 11, soon to be Year 12.

This year's NCS Angmering bespoke summer programme will be a 2-week experience starting on Monday 11th July – Friday 22nd July (not including weekends), giving your teen the chance to gain independence, get out the house and stay away from home.

Week 1 - Residential location tbc - Monday 11th July to Friday 15th July

- **Phase 1** will give your teen the chance to test and challenge themselves by trying out new adrenaline filled activities. They will also stay away from home and have food and transport provided.
- <u>Phase 2</u> Your teen will learn the skills needed for work, further education and independent living. Completing various workshops to enhance their skills and increase their self-confidence, your teen will pick up a lot in this phase.

Week 2 - Non-Residential meeting daily at Angmering School - Monday 18th July to Friday 22nd July

- <u>Phase 3</u> will allow your teen to plan their own project for a cause that's close to their heart and then action it to help their local communities and really make a difference.
- <u>Phase 4</u> will allow them to let their hair down and celebrate everything they've achieved! They'll also receive a signed certificate from the Prime Minister
