Year 11 Prom – Partnership Agreement for Attendance

The Year 11 Prom is a special occasion for students, families, and staff to celebrate the hard work, dedication, and achievements of our students as they complete their time at The Angmering School.

Attending the Prom is a privilege, and we want to work in partnership to ensure that every student meets the expectations required to take part in this memorable event.

Eligibility Criteria

To be invited to the Year 11 Prom, students must meet the following expectations:

Maintaining Good Attendance

Students are expected to aim for an attendance rate of 90% or above.

If there are exceptional circumstances affecting attendance (e.g. medical conditions with supporting evidence), these will be reviewed on an individual basis.

Demonstrating Good Behaviour

Students are expected to uphold high standards of behaviour throughout the year and to have earned at least 1,000 ARC points.

Any serious incidents of misconduct, fixed-term exclusions, or persistent disruptive behaviour may result in the withdrawal of a Prom invitation.

We will work with students and families to support positive choices; however, we reserve the right to withdraw attendance if expectations are not met.

Meeting School Expectations

Students are encouraged to actively engage with their learning and follow the school's values.

Participation in interventions, revision sessions, and GCSE exams is an essential part of this commitment.

Behaviour Expectations on the Day of the Prom

To ensure a safe and enjoyable evening, students are expected to:

- **Avoid intoxication:** Students must not consume alcohol or any other substances before or during the event.
- **Avoid illegal substances:** Any student found in possession of, or under the influence of, prohibited substances will be removed, and further action may be taken.
- **Show respect:** Students must behave appropriately, treating staff, peers, and venue staff with respect.
- **Follow venue rules:** All students must comply with venue policies, including any security checks upon arrival.

If a student does not meet these expectations on the night, parents/carers will be contacted and required to collect their child immediately.

Final Decisions



The school reserves the right to make the final decision regarding a student's eligibility based on attendance, behaviour, and overall engagement.

We want this to be a positive and inclusive celebration for all Year 11 students. By working together - students, families, and staff - we can ensure that everyone has the opportunity to enjoy this special evening.
