Dear Parents/Guardians

Re: An Inspector Calls Theatre trip - 17 November 2022 - Brighton Theatre Royal

The English department is delighted to offer the current Year 9 and 10 students the opportunity to see *An Inspector Calls* at the Theatre Royal, Brighton on Thursday 17 November 2022 at 14.30.

“From **Stephen Daldry**, the Oscar nominated director of *The Reader*, *The Hours* and one of Britain's best-loved films *Billy Elliot*, comes the magnificent production of **J.B. Priestley's** classic thriller, **An Inspector Calls** - direct from its fourth West End season.”

This will be a fantastic opportunity to enhance students' understanding and study of the text for their GCSE exam.

We have 100 tickets available that are being offered to the current Year 9 and Year 10 students. Please note the seats are situated in the Second Circle so are high up.

We will be leaving Angmering School at 1 pm to travel by coach to Brighton and should arrive back at Angmering School at around **5.30 pm**.
As we are leaving school before lunchtime, we would ask students to eat at breaktime and at the theatre, as we cannot eat on the coach.

The voluntary contribution for the trip is £23.00.

The price includes theatre ticket, coach travel and parent pay fee. Payment for the trip will be required via ParentPay by **Friday 10 June** as we need to pay for the theatre tickets by the end of June.

If the trip is over subscribed, places will be allocated by ballot. You will be advised shortly after the 13 May if your child has a place and details will be put

onto Parent Pay. Please do not try to pay until you have confirmation that your child has a place on the trip.

We must tell you that, as the school could not bear any of the costs of the trip without reducing its ability to provide the books and materials that are essential for its curricular needs, the trip cannot take place unless all parents who are able to are willing to contribute. If you would like your son/daughter to participate, but are unable to contribute the full amount, please contact me in confidence, in writing, by **Friday 13 May**.

Should there be changes in government guidelines which results in a trip having to be cancelled as has happened previously during the Covid 19 pandemic , we are no longer able to claim on WSCC insurance for any loss. For this reason we are now only booking trips where the company providing the trip offers a robust cancellation/refund system in respect of Covid cancellations

At the time of writing there are currently no Government Covid restrictions that may apply to this trip. However, as the Covid 19 situation may change, we will have to follow the Government guidance in place at the time of the trip. This may also include specific requirements that the theatre has at that time.

Therefore it is necessary to point out that should your child be unwell at the time of the trip or is unable to take part in the trip due to Covid 19 restrictions that affect them, then unless we are able to find a student to your child's place, you will not receive a refund for the place you have booked.
